Thank you for your donations for Resources for Women.

Resources for Women was established on March 31, 2014. In that first year, they had 133 appointments. NOW,



they average 120 appointments/month! During COVID they are still able to offer curbside pick ups of various items: diapers, wipes, formula, clothes and educational handouts. They are also seeing clients and taking all the precautions necessary to protect volunteers, staff and clients

About the clients

- 70% of clients are single and 55% of clients are between the ages of 20 to 30.
- They serve a diverse group of women: 35% Hispanic, 32% Caucasian and 26% African American.
- The highest level of education for clients is 37% have some college, 25% graduated from high school, 14% have graduated college, 10% completed a trade school and 5% have less than a high school education.
- 26% of clients are unemployed or on welfare, 20% make less than \$14,000 a year and 15% are dependents (which means a student or wife.)

How can you help:

- Pray for the ministry
- Donate funds
- Donate goods (diapers, wipes, clothing)
- Volunteers: All volunteers go through about 10 to 16 hours of training. The next new volunteer orientation is Thursday, Feb. 4 from 6-7:30 p.m.

What types of volunteers are needed:

- Receptionists to answer the phones
- Life Mentors to lead the Step by Step lessons
- Pregnancy Advocate meets with clients
- Ultrasound chaperone to talk to the client while she is having the ultrasound to make her feel comfortable and ask her about how she is feeling about the pregnancy
- Spiritual Mentors who come in to pray with the client with her permission.
