Pill Bottle Recycling

Matthew 25: Ministries accepts donations of empty plastic pill bottles. They will accept prescription and over-the-counter pill bottles, large or small with plastic lids (child-resistant and other). Remove labels, leaving no glue or residue. Wash bottles in very hot water and dish soap using alcohol, nail polish remover or lemon essential oil to remove stickiness. Rinse and dry thoroughly. 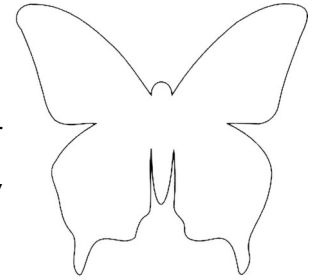
- For high school students, the duration is 9 consecutive weeks over the summer (June 9 to August 7)
