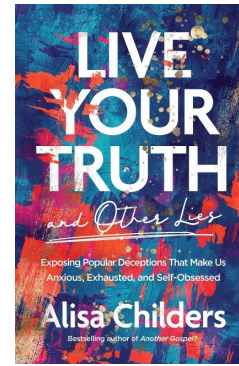
### Popular Lies

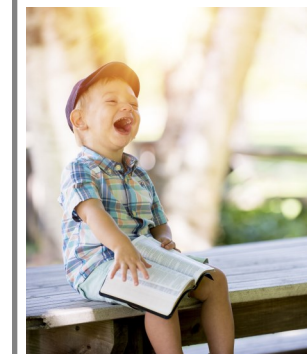
## Children's Ministry

Please pick up your children from their classroom at the end of the worship service.

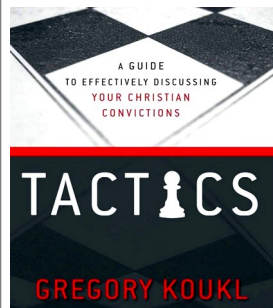


A **Nursery** room is available in the yellow classroom through the door under the left screen.

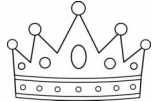
