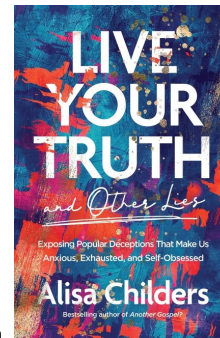

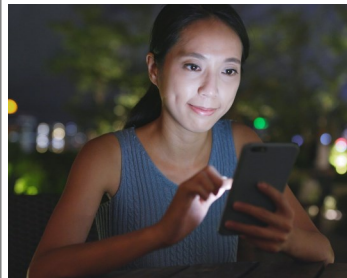
Lie 6: God Wants You to be Happy

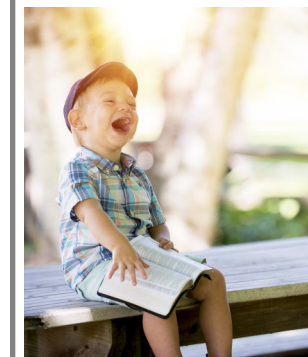

Children's Activity Bags are available in the lobby. They include activity books, coloring sheets, crayons and more. Please return the bags to the "tree" after the service.

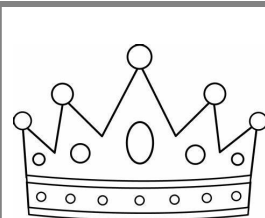
Building a Bigger Heaven in Texas

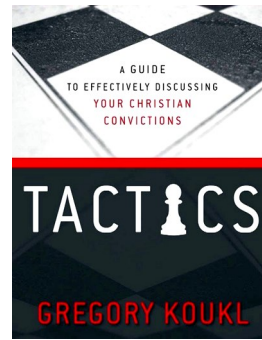
Summer Camp Registration

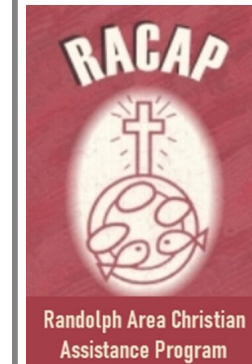
A Girl and a Gun Women's Gun Safety Workshop
