Jesus Love Me - Three Solas Reformation

"Jesus loves me, this I know, for the Bible tells me so!"
This simple and familiar tune shares deep Gospel truths. It speaks of human frailty and the need for a Savior and how that need was provided in the Mighty One, Jesus Christ.
The very first line bears out the very tenets of the Reformation. The first clause, "Jesus loves me," speaks of grace alone. By the love of Christ, the One who died to declare us righteous before God, we are redeemed, restored, and forgiven. By His sacrificial death we are saved. We are weak and cannot bring anything before God, but Jesus is strong and has done everything to satisfy God's demand of justice. By grace alone we are saved. By Jesus' love alone we are saved.

"This I know," speaks of faith alone. Christ died for all. The sacrifice He made on Calvary was made for all people. Is it some magical feeling of emotion in the pit of our stomach? Is it some mystical connection that we need a sign from heaven to reveal to us? No, but it is another gift of God's love. The "this I know" is faith, the gift of faith given to us by the Holy Spirit. And what does it do? It's like a limb that clings to the life preserver of salvation.

Finally, "for the Bible tells me so," speaks of Scripture alone. How do we learn of this grace? How do we learn more and are strengthened day by day in this faith? It is our great heritage—God's Word. It is a heritage that was rediscovered by the Lord's grace through his servant, Martin Luther. God's Word assures us of Jesus' love and strengthens our faith.


