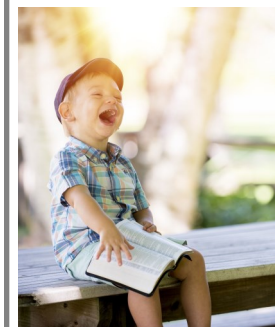
Children's Ministry

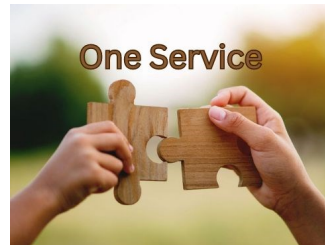


Christmas Eve Candlelight Service

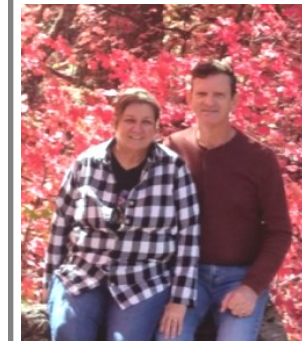
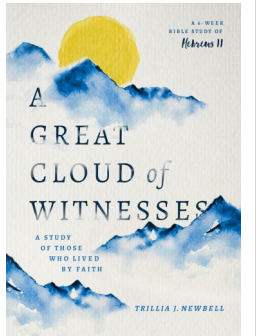
Sometimes Saturday Sisterhood (SSS)
