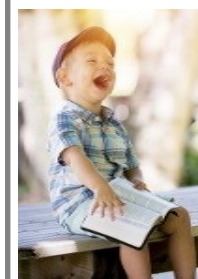

Current Life Lesson Series: **Glory in the Cross**

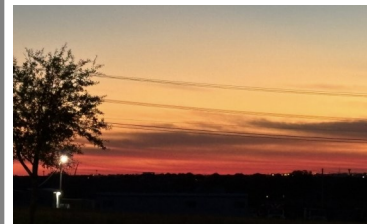

Sunset here on our hill is quite beautiful. Weather permitting, we're setting aside time during Lent to

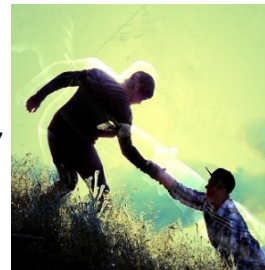
