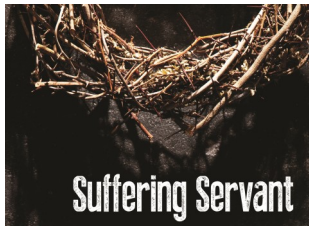

JAM (Jesus & Me) - 4 yr old thru 3rd grade;

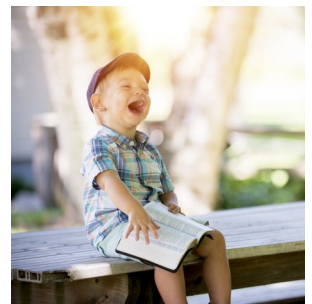
'Tweens—4th thru 6th grade

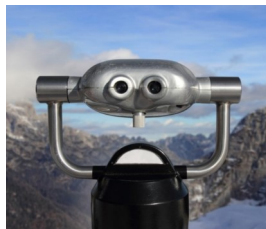
Children Ministry Volunteers

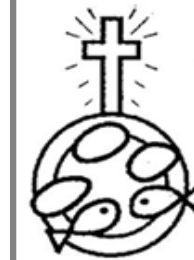
Pill Bottle Recycling
