Remove labels, leaving no glue or residue. Wash bottles in very hot water and dish soap using alcohol, nail polish remover or lemon essential oil to remove stickiness. Rinse and dry thoroughly. Nursery

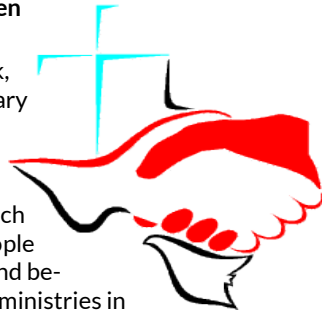

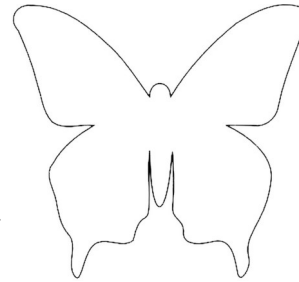
Sunday School Returns
