New Life Lesson Series : The Lion

The prophet Amos tells us that the Lion appears and roars judgment surprisingly against God's people. We should be afraid. But we should also love and trust the Lion of Judah who comes between God's wrath and us.

TODAY: Upside Down

Have you ever been upside down? God directs Amos to proclaim a message which is just the opposite of what is expected... or wanted. It's not a message we want to hear, but one we need to hear to prepare us for the great reversal and rescue.



NEXT WEEK: Missed it

On "the day of the Lord," God's people expected to be delivered from their enemies. How surprised they were to discover they were the enemy! For Israel, the day of the Lord is one of darkness, not light. It didn't have to be this way. What will the day of Lord be for you?

- are more receptive to the faith than the US average,
- prefer activities which support faith development,
- prefer worship, music and architectural styles which are somewhat contemporary (Percept Group).

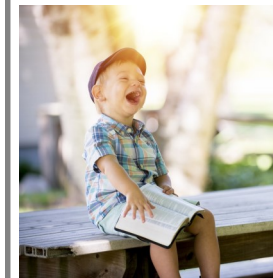

Children may be picked up from their classroom at the end of the worship service.

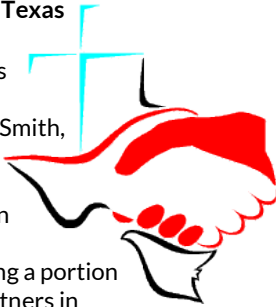


Nursery is available in the yellow classroom. To access the room use the door to the left of the stage.

Word of Life is seeking an administrative assistant to attend to the many different administrative duties of the church including managing records, business, communications, facilities

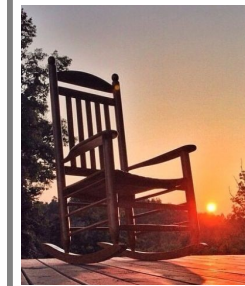
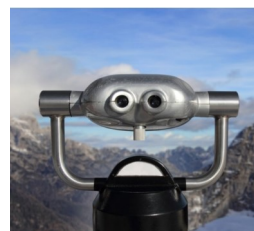
and developing volunteers and systems to help Word of Life Fellowship build a bigger heaven and better lives.

Stephen Ministers are trained in topics including listening, feelings, assertiveness, and confidentiality. They minister to people in transitional situations such as divorce, terminal illness, grief and childbirth.

Stephen Ministers are also trained to recognize when a care receiver's needs go beyond the care a Stephen Minister can provide and know where the care receiver may seek additional care.

Confidentiality is a cornerstone of Stephen Ministry. Stephen Ministers don't reveal what their care receivers have told them: not to the pastor, not to Stephen Leaders, not to spouses or friends, and not to other Stephen Ministers. Want to know more?
