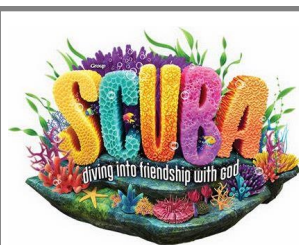

Join us for coffee, tea, and assorted snacks after each of the morning services. Enjoy delightful conversation. Have a snack you want to share? Please bring it!



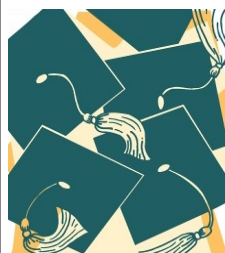
SCUBA VBS

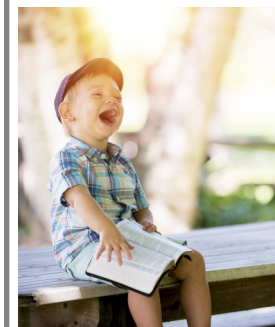

Please pick up your children from their classroom at the end of the worship service.

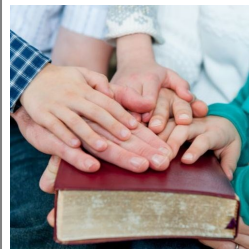


A Nursery room is available in the yellow classroom through the door under the left screen.

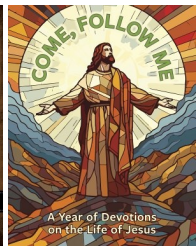
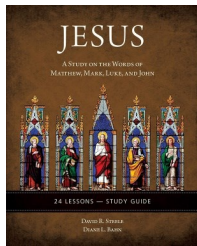


Everyday Discipleship

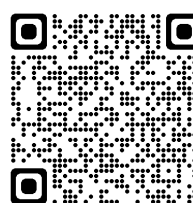
Electronic Check—Write the fund/funds you want to give to in the memo or account number field in your bank or credit union's bill pay feature.

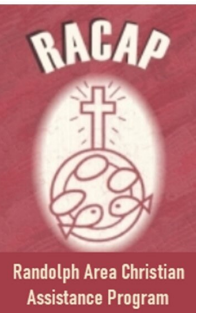
Cash—Write the fund/funds you want to give to on an offering envelope and place it in the box near the door.

The online service provider will retain a transaction fee of \$.49 plus 1.99% of the total amount of your donation. These are the lowest fees we could find.



RACAP (Randolph Area Christian Assistance Program) has been serving the community for 42 years! Twenty four member churches help assist families in 8 local zip codes. They operate a food pantry and provide emergency assistance to people in need.



What RACAP did in April, with your help:

- 87 Families
- 240 People
- 188 People fed
- 68 Pantry Visits
- 33 Rental assistance
- 33 Utility Assistance
- 41 Repeat Clients
- 46 New Clients

Current pantry needs:
