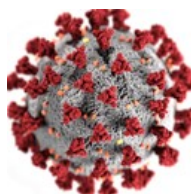
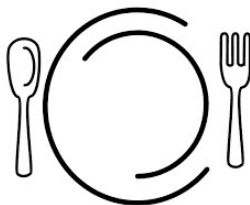

New Guidance

New guidance concerning those who are vaccinated was issued by the CDC on May 13. As a result, we've changed the health protocols at Word of Life.

Masks are now optional.

Please consider this or the advice of your health care professional as you exercise your best Christian judgment in your decisions. Also:

- **If you prefer to wear a mask, please do so!** Each of us must do what is best for our health and the health of others. Several studies have shown that while wearing a mask primarily protects those around you, it also protects you.
- **Please be sensitive to the people around you.** Those who have been fully vaccinated have an extremely low chance of getting COVID-19 and an even lower chance of transmitting it. Some will be unvaccinated or have other complicating conditions that place them at risk. Please show respect and concern for everyone.
- **Before you sit closer than 6 feet to someone outside your household, kindly ask if they are comfortable with this.** If not, there are plenty seats in our three services at 8:30, 9:45 and now 11:00.

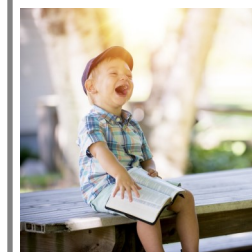

For Children

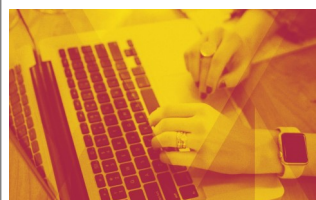
