### Next Sunday—**Lighten Your Load**

Jesus summarized the secret of managing stress in two sentences: “Come to Me, all you that are weary and are carrying heavy burdens, and I will give you rest. Take My yoke upon you, and learn from Me; for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For My yoke is easy, and My burden is light.” Matthew 11:28-30. If you do these three things, your stress will go down, your satisfaction will go up, and your load will be lighter.

## History of Juneteenth

Sunday, June 19, 2022, is Juneteenth, also known as Freedom Day or Emancipation Day. Juneteenth celebrates the freedom of more than 250,000 slaves at the close of the Civil War. Union troops, led by Major General Gordon Granger, arrived in Galveston, Texas on June 19, 1865 to enforce the Emancipation Proclamation. News of the war's end and the executive order to end slavery did not reach Texas until two and a half years after the Confederate surrender at Appomattox. Juneteenth became a state holiday in Texas in 1980, but it was not until 2021 that the day was recognized as a federal holiday.

## For Children

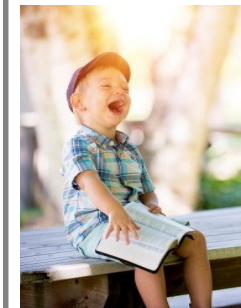
We are so happy you have brought your children to worship today. After the Children's Message in both contemporary services, children, Infants—6th grade, are invited to attend age
