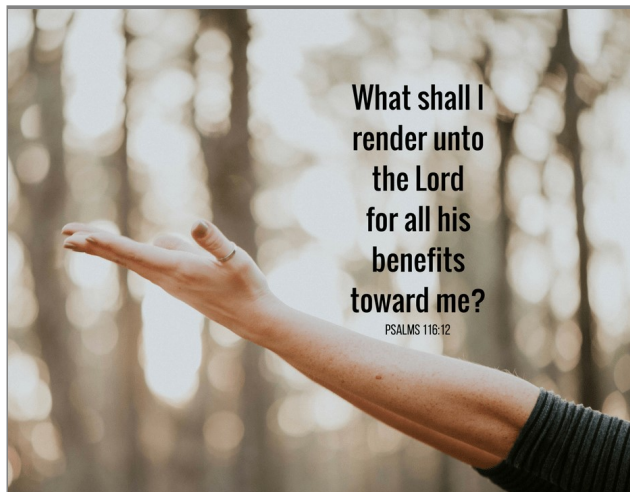

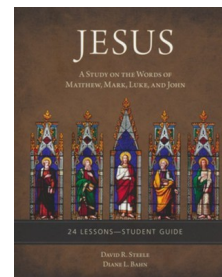

### Word of Life Fellowship

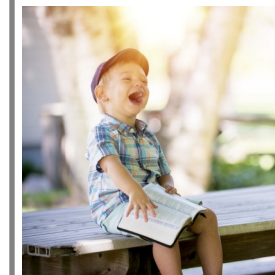

### Compassionate Christian Personal Caregiving

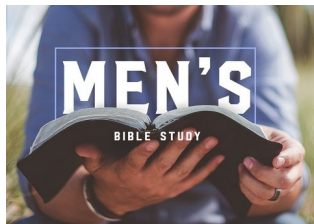
