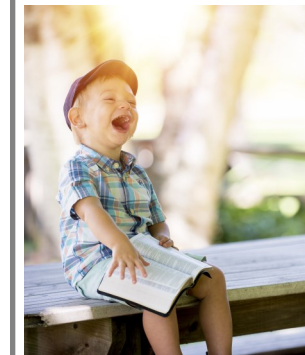
## Children's Ministry

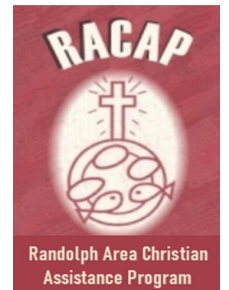
The Lutheran Center for Religious Liberty is grateful for the financial support of donors who support the ministry. Without their generous gifts,
