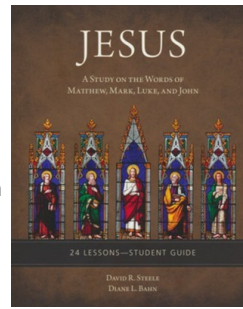


Silver Serenaders

Welcome!

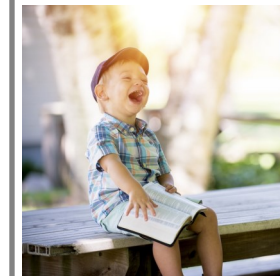
