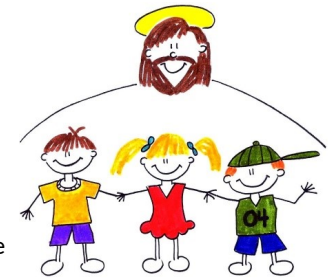

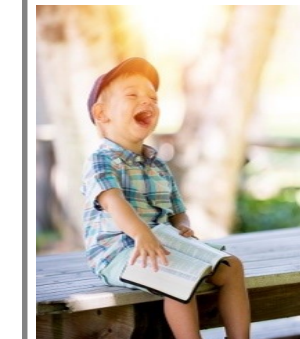


Welcome!

Hurricane Ian Update

Rev. James Rockey, President of the Florida -Georgia District, shared the following:



Our initial contacts with Pastors around the District are nothing but amazing! As of this time, no church facility has been damaged beyond use (although some reports are still tentative). We know of 3 called workers with water damage from the tidal surge and two with roof and other damage making their homes uninhabitable at this time. We have no reports of serious injuries or death from our congregations, but contact is still very difficult with limited power and cellular service. It does appear that there may be as many as 200 deaths on Fort Myers Beach from the tidal surge...so we pray for God's comfort upon those families.

Please continue to pray for those who are in the path of the continuing storm and for all who were impacted. Pray that the Lord will use the relief efforts to turn many toward the One who is the only true Hope and Refuge for this life and eternity!
