Blood Drive

During the Fall Festival (Saturday, Oct. 25), the South Texas Blood & Tissue Bloodmobile will be in the parking lot for a blood drive. Donors will need to bring a valid photo ID and can donate beginning at 10 am.

To donate blood, you must:

- Be at least 16 years old with a signed parental consent form or 17 years old or older.
- Weigh at least 110 pounds.
- Be in good general health and feeling well.
- Complete a donor questionnaire and mini-physical (pulse, temperature, blood pressure, iron levels).

Scan the QR code to schedule a time to donate OR stop by the bloodmobile on Oct. 25.

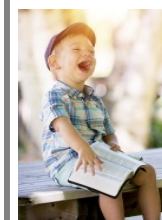

- I have been baptized in the name of the Triune God and am able to examine myself as instructed by Scripture. *1 Corinthians 11:26-32*
- I believe I am a sinner, and by God's grace I turn away from my sins and toward Jesus. *Proverbs 28:13*
- I believe in Jesus as my Savior and Lord. *Hebrews 11:6*
- I believe that in the physical elements of bread and wine Christ offers the real presence of His body and blood for the forgiveness of sins. *Matthew 26:26-28 & 1 Corinthians 10:16*
- I am ready to be united with Word of Life Church through the body and blood of Christ. *1 Corinthians 10:16-17*
- I intend with the help of the Holy Spirit to change my sinful ways and live a more Christ-like, godly life, trusting in God's promises and obeying His commands. *Ephesians 4:22-24*

Instructions

- If you cannot receive wine, non-alcoholic wine is in the center of the tray.
- Adults who choose not to commune, please keep your hands folded to receive a spoken blessing from the pastor. Please let a pastor know if you desire baptism or instruction.
- Children and youth who have not been instructed in our teachings, please keep your hands folded and receive a spoken blessing from the pastor.
