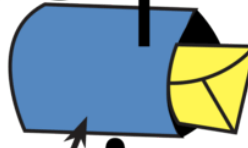


Building a Bigger Heaven in Texas

You've Got Mail



Reopening?

You received an **IMPORTANT** email this week from your **Leadership TEAM**. In it we asked for your response regarding our return to regular in-person worship. The email stated that Governor Abbott has released minimum health protocols for churches to follow in re-opening. The full list can be found online, but here are some highlights:

- Keep at least 2 empty seats (or 6 feet) between families.
- Every other row must be removed or left empty.
- Screen everyone before coming into the building.
- Do not allow individuals with symptoms to enter/return.
- Do not allow individuals to enter who have known contact with someone with Covid-19.
- Disinfect all surfaces: doorknobs, tables, chairs, restrooms, pews, etc. between each use.
- Make all sanitizing and cleaning supplies readily available.
- No snacks, coffee or shared food.

Everyone who received the email was asked to respond to the following :

- **YES or NO** - If we re-opened our building for worship in June and implemented the minimum health protocols, while continuing to provide an online worship option, **would you attend at the building?**
- If YES, which **service time** do you prefer (please note, with physically spaced seating our capacity will be limited to about 40 per service and may require pre-registering)?
- If YES, **how would you choose to help:** wipe down seats after service, hold open and wipe door handles, wipe down bathroom surfaces after use, gracefully encourage distancing, serve as needed?

Your response is critical to our decision making. If you have not responded, please do so **TODAY!**
