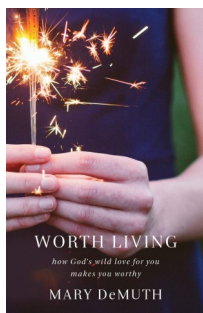
Rise N Shine Church Cleaning

Experiencing God Bible Study

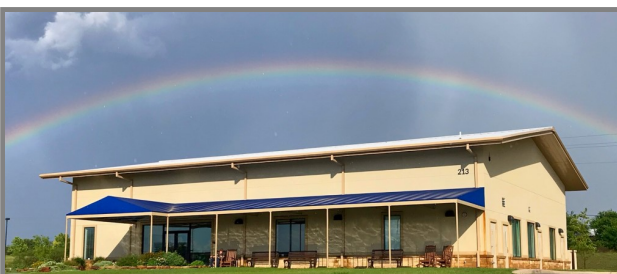

New Service Times—Consider a Traditional Service

After last Sunday's attendance, your Leadership TEAM added another Sunday morning worship option, an **8:30 a.m.** traditional service followed by a **9:45 a.m.** contemporary service.

If you are joining us in person, please observe all current health safety protocols. This includes 1) staying home if you have any COVID-19 symptoms or have had close contact with a person who has COVID, 2) wearing a cloth face covering over both your nose and mouth, 3) sanitizing or washing your hands upon entering and often, 4) staying 6 ft away (about 2 seats or arm lengths) from all people not in your household, 5) covering your cough or sneeze.

After the service, please disinfect the area where you were seated with a provided wipe and remove any paper items your household may have touched.

RACAP Food Pantry
