Thanksgiving Week

Are you going to have a “happy” thanksgiving this year?

1. The ten _____ had little to make them happy.

Luke 17:11-13—Jesus traveled along the border between Samaria and Galilee on his way to Jerusalem. As he went into a village, ten men with a skin disease met him. They stood at a distance and shouted, “Jesus, Teacher, have mercy on us!”
