Series based on Scripture and *Live Your Truth and Other Lies* by Alisa Childers

1. What is postmodern truth?

Postmodernism is a worldview which:

- is skeptical of the use of science, technology, reason and logic,
- is suspicious of current ideologies, organizations and power structures,
- rejects certainty and stability of knowledge and meaning,
- deconstructs traditions and traditional ways of thinking and redefines reality,
- embraces subjectivism of morals and truth.

Postmodern thought: "What's true for you is true for you, but what's true for me is true for me."

A postmodern redefinition of Christianity:

- Incarnation is no longer God becoming flesh but Jesus achieving enlightenment and the mystery of the Cosmic Christ.
- Atonement is no longer Jesus dying on the cross as a sacrifice for our sins but an example of how to forgive.
- Resurrection is no longer a resurrected Christ but a metaphor for new life after hardship.

3. Is Christianity True?
Hebrews 2:3-4 (GW) - So how will we escape punishment if we reject the important message, the message that God saved us? First, the Lord told this saving message. Then those who heard him confirmed that message. God verified what they said through miraculous signs, amazing things, other powerful acts, and with other gifts from the Holy Spirit as he wanted.
The saving message is by signs, amazing things, powerful acts and Spiritual gifts.
1 Corinthians 15:3-8a (GW) - I passed on to you the most important points of doctrine that I had received: Christ died to take away our sins as the Scriptures predicted. He was placed in a tomb. He was brought back to life on the third day as the Scriptures predicted. He appeared to Cephas. Next he appeared to the twelve apostles. Then he appeared to more than 500 believers at one time. (Most of these people are still living, but some have died.) Next he appeared to James. Then he appeared to all the apostles. Last of all, he also appeared to me.
The most important points of our teachings were
verified by many
1 Corinthians 15:14, 17 (GW) - If Christ has not been raised, our preaching is useless and so is your faith. If Christ hasn't come back to life, your faith is worthless and sin still has you in its power.

According to Dr. Gary Habermas, there is enough evidence from non-Biblical writings, including those of skeptics, to learn important historical details about Jesus and his followers, for example:

- Jesus died by Roman crucifixion.
- Jesus' disciples believed Jesus rose from the dead, appeared to them and many others, and were willing to suffer and die for those beliefs.
- Paul, who persecuted the Christian church, became a Christian after an experience which he believed to be an appearance of the risen Christ.
- James, the brother of Jesus, suddenly converted to Christianity after he believed he saw his brother after he was raised back to life.

The explanation which makes the most sense is that from the dead.

4. Is It Your Truth or The Truth?

Alisa Childers' questions to ask when analyzing ideas:

Your Truth

- Are you being asked to bypass your mind or rational thinking?
- Is the imagination seen as superior to and separate from your logical, rational mind?
- Is truth in this situation dependent on how it makes you or someone else feel?

The Truth

- Is this statement or situation based on reality supported by evidence?
- Are you engaging your imagination while still accessing your logical, rational mind?
- Is truth in this situation dependent on what the Word of God says?

John 14:6 (GW) - Jesus answered him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one goes to the Father except through me."
