Top Temptations

A 2011 study tracked the top temptations Americans face. The people surveyed said they struggled with the following temptations either "often" or "sometimes":



- Worrying or being anxious—60%
- Procrastinating or putting things off—60%
- Eating too much—55%
- Spending too much time on media—44%
- Being lazy—41%
- Spending more money than they could afford—35%
- Gossiping about others—26%
- Being jealous or envious of others—24%
- Viewing pornography or sexually explicit material— 18%
- Abusing alcohol or drugs—11%

When asked if they tried to do anything specific to avoid giving in to a temptation, 41% said yes and 59% said no. When people were asked why they give in to temptations, the top four reasons were:

- I am not really sure—50%
- To escape or get away from "real life"—20%
- To feel less pain or loneliness—8%
- To satisfy other people's expectations of me—7%
