

# Unusual Thanks

Suffering—Oddly, God works to deepen and strengthen our faith and reliance upon him when we go through trials and hardships (Hebrews 12:7-11).

**Sin**—Certainly, the world would've



Salt—Jesus calls us the salt of the earth, meaning that God allows us to participate in his plan of redemption by using us to give others a taste of what it means to be one of God's children (Matthew 5:13).

**Light**—Jesus called himself the light of the world (John 8:12). And he called his children light (Matthew 5:14-16), because we're his reflection to those around us.

Clay and vessels—Because we acknowledge God as Creator (Isaiah 64:8), he uses us to accomplish his service and ministry (2 Timothy 2:20-21).

**Sword**—God has given us an instruction book—his Word—that penetrates our very being and shapes our attitudes and thoughts if we allow it to (Ephesians 6:17; Hebrews 4:12).

**Blood**—Through the blood of Christ we receive forgiveness of our sins and the promise of eternal life (John 19:34: Hebrews 9:12).

**Thorns**—Jesus suffered ultimate humiliation at his crucifixion so that we could be restored to a right relationship with God (Matthew 27:29).

**Stone**—While the stone at Jesus' tomb signified death, it was also rolled away, signifying Jesus' resurrection (Matthew 27:60; 28:2). The Apostle Peter later referred to Christ as the "living stone" and a "precious cornerstone," and called Christ's followers living stones (1 Peter 2:4-9).

Trumpet—Because of our eternal hope through the redemptive work of Christ, we can anticipate his return with excitement (1 Corinthians 15:52; 1 Thessalonians 4:16-17). -from Rev. Magazine
