Jesus Tells About His Resurrection

Luke 24:13-34

Bible Point: We accept God's forgiveness.

Tip for Children's Ministry Director:

Buzz Bond

Each person will answer a question based on which color they're wearing more of:

- Red, orange, or pink: Tell about how you helped around the house this week.
- Green, blue, or purple: Tell about what you saw on TV this week.

God Sightings

To help kids look for God all the time, tell about a time this week you saw God at work in your life. Then encourage your kids to share stories of their own.

Bible Buzz

Word Smart: Hear It!

Open your Bible to Luke 24, and show everyone the words. SAY: **Let's hear what God's special book, the Bible, says about how Jesus appeared to two of his followers after he came back to life. *Followers* are people who walked with Jesus and believed in him. When I say "Jesus," put your hand up and point to the sky. When you hear "alive," jump up one time and then**

sit back down. Let's practice. Jesus! (put your hand up and point to the sky). **Alive!** (jump one time and then sit back down).

After Jesus (pause) **came back to life, two of his followers were walking together, talking about his death. Jesus** (pause) **came along and walked with them, but they didn't know it was him. Jesus** (pause) **asked them what they were talking about. They said that Jesus** (pause) **had died, and now, after three days, his body was missing, and some people said that Jesus** (pause) **was alive** (pause) **again. Jesus** (pause) **then told them what the Bible said about how he would die but come alive** (pause) **again. He told them they could believe Jesus** (pause) **is alive** (pause).

Later that night, Jesus (pause) **ate with them. As soon as he broke the bread and gave it to them, the two followers realized that the man was Jesus** (pause). **Suddenly, Jesus** (pause) **just disappeared! The two followers believed Jesus** (pause) **was truly alive** (pause)!

ASK: The people on the road asked Jesus questions. If you could ask Jesus a question, what would you ask him?

What are some ways you know Jesus is with you all the time?

SAY: We don't get to see Jesus like his followers did. But he shows us he's with us all the time! When WE ACCEPT GOD'S FORGIVENESS, we can remember that Jesus is with us.

Picture Smart: Mask It!

Supplies: paper, markers

SAY: Jesus didn't want the two followers he began speaking with to know who he was right away. He didn't need to use a mask to hide his face, but if you or I wanted to keep someone from recognizing us, wearing a mask might be a good way to do it. We've seen a lot of people wearing masks lately to protect themselves and others from Coronavirus!

We're going to make masks to remind us that Jesus didn't want the two followers to recognize him. Our masks can be fun disguises! Parents can help the children determine where they should make holes for their eyes and mouths, and mark those places on their masks.

SAY: Draw any face you want on your mask. Make it look different from your face. Maybe you could be another person, or even an animal! As kids draw their faces, parents will cut out their eye and mouth holes for them.

SAY: Hold your mask over your face while we talk about some questions.

ASK: What do you think Jesus looks like?

How do you recognize Jesus when he shows his love in your life?

SAY: Jesus recognizes you (even behind your mask!) and wants to forgive you. WE ACCEPT GOD'S FORGIVENESS.
